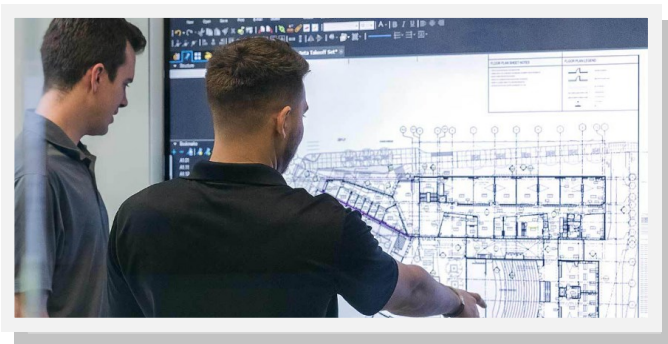

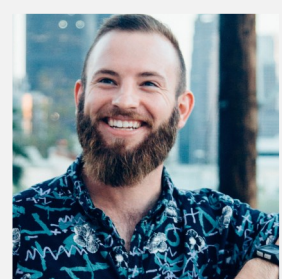

1a) BLUEBEAM REVU BASICS FOR BEGINNERS

Tuesday, April 11, 8:30 am—12:30 pm

This course is designed for members who have never used Bluebeam Revu or are at a beginner's skill level. In the Bluebeam Basics course, you will acquire the foundational skills necessary to begin using Bluebeam Revu to organize, markup, edit and track comments in a PDF drawing set.

1b) BLUEBEAM REVU BASICS FOR INTERMEDIATE USERS

Tuesday, April 11, 1:00 —5:00 pm

This course is designed for members who have basic experience using Revu and are at an intermediate skill level. The Basics for Intermediate users course will take a look at advanced tips and tricks for more efficient work within Revu.

2) DOCUMENT MANAGEMENT/CONTROL AND COLLABORATION

Wednesday, April 12, 8:30 am—12:30 pm

This course will cover the tools in Revu used for digital drawing set organization throughout the lifecycle of a project. You'll learn how to organize a large drawing set, how to detect changes quickly when sheets are revised, how to easily navigate a large set by linking all drawings, RFIs and other project documents and view a past history of revisions. Finally we'll cover options for sharing your drawing set with the field and for easy project team collaboration using Studio

3) MEASUREMENTS AND TAKEOFFS IN REVU

Wednesday, April 12, 1:00—5:00 pm

In this course, you will learn to use Revu's measurement tools for takeoffs. The course begins with the basics, such as setting up your interface for takeoffs and calibrating your drawing sets. The focus then shifts to learning to use the various measurement tools Revu offers for takeoff purposes, as well as how to export data for estimation.
